To: Non-Private Passenger Automobile Insurers

Subject: Rating Profiles

In order to standardize reporting the Insurance Bureau of Canada (IBC) and the Canadian Automobile Insurance Rate Regulators Association (CARR) have developed insurance rating profiles for non-private passenger vehicles. Alberta has decided to adopt these profiles and will be implementing the non-private passenger rating profiles as of January 1, 2016. Insurers must include these completed rating profiles with filings relating to non-private passenger rating programs submitted on or after January 1, 2016.

The profiles are posted on the AIRB website at www.airb.alberta.ca/filing-guidelines/ with notes and instructions. The forms for the profiles, as well as filing guidelines under the *Automobile Insurance Premiums Regulation* can be found there also.

Please share this notice with any individuals involved in the development of filings. The AIRB website should be checked periodically to ensure the most current version of the filing guidelines is being used.

The AIRB will be posting the profiles on the AIRB website. All insurers must submit the profiles no later than March 15, 2016, if they have not been provided through a previous filing. See the rating profiles form on the AIRB website for specific instructions.
