

Notice to Interested Parties

Collaboration on Centralized Industry Data

Purpose

The Automobile Insurance Rate Board (AIRB) is issuing this notice to advise all interested parties we have collaborated with the Facility Association (FA) on a centralized industry data initiative in support of Alberta's transition to the Care-First auto insurance model.

Background

The AIRB heard from insurers timely, credible, industry-level data is critical to support pricing assumptions for segmentation of accident benefits coverage under Care-First. The AIRB collaborated with the Facility Association to develop and release this dataset will enhance insurers' ability to calibrate rates, estimate loss costs and support future analysis related to segmentation and mix of business considerations.

Announcement

This initiative will support insurer segmentation for accident benefits under Care-First and the potential development of a mix of business adjustment for use in 2028 and future years. As part of this work, FA and AIRB are jointly producing a regulated, validated dataset derived from the General Insurance Statistical Agency's (GISA) Alberta Auto Statistical Plan (ASP) data and FA's Underwriting Information Plan (UIP) data.
